Why Indonesia?

GESS Indonesia has the full support of the Ministry of Education and Culture, Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education, Ministry of Religious Affairs and the Jakarta Education Board.

- Government spending is proposed at IDR 2,070.5 trillion (approx. USD \$158 billion) in the 2017 budget with 20% of all government expenditure devoted to education.
- The government aims to provide universal access to senior secondary education for all young people by 2019.
- Between 2011 and 2013, Indonesia's GDP passed the USD 1 trillion and GDP growth has been above 6% per year since.
- The market value of the higher education sector in Indonesia expects to reach \$15bn by 2030 compared to \$3bn in 2014.
- Indonesia expects to have a workforce of 65 million young people by 2035.

Stand Package

There is an opportunity to take advantage of the **'early bird'** exhibiting rate, which is valid until **18 February 2018.** The cost before this date is \$405 per sqm (min. 9sqm) for shell scheme and \$425 per sqm after this date. Shell schemes includes: walls, fascia, grey carpet, 2 x 40W florescent lamps, 2 amp socket (per 9sqm), reception desk with lockable counter, 2 x chairs and a waste bin.
