 - c) the exhibition organisers' terms, conditions, rules and regations.
- 2.3 The company shall ensure that it has full insurance cover againaccident, injury, loss or damage of any nature including public and product lidibj. The company shall also comply with any requirements of BESA, the organisand any applicable law in this regard.

3 CONTRA ACCOUNTS

BESA reserve the right to deduct from any sums due or which magecome due to the company under this or any other contract with BESA, any sum which is due or which may become due to BESA from the company under this or anyther contract.

4 DAMAGE

No damage may be caused to the display aids/furniture suppliced dif so caused companies will be liable for the full cost of repletement.

5 VARIATION OF COSTS

6 FAILURE TO PAY

7 CANCELLATIONS

8 CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT
