Alongside Learning & Teaching Expo the co-located Asia-Pacific International Schools Conference is attended by international school leaders from the vibrant international schools' sector in the region.

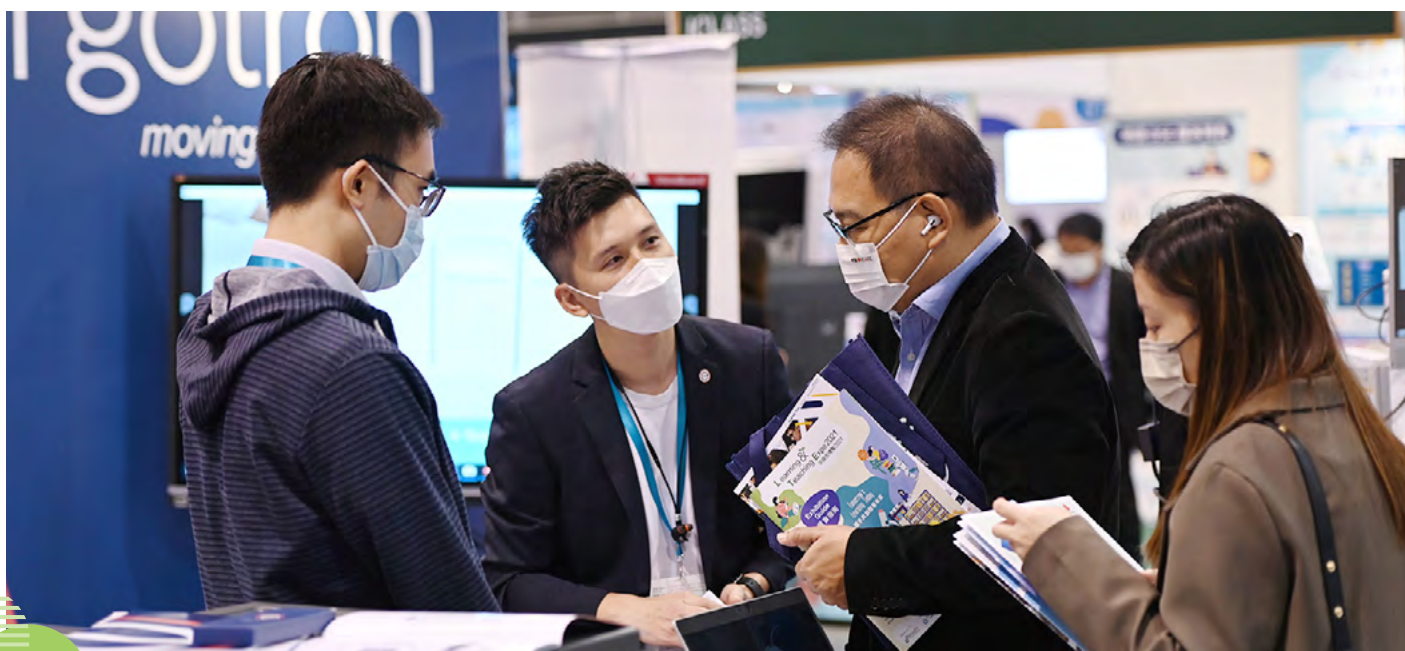
