

## **Asia Education Market at a Glance**

## Early Childhood, Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Education

The education market in the Asia Pacific region is changing. Many countries and regions are increasing investment in education, recognising its importance for economic development and social progress.



#### The Expanding International Schools Market

As of January 2024, ISC Research data recorded 14,010 English-medium international schools worldwide, enrolling 6.9 million students between 3 and 18 and employing 664,645 teaching staff. The sector continues to grow as parents seek educational choices for their children that guarantee quality and put students on a path to a global future.

Asia dominates the international schools market with nearly 60% of the world's international schools, collectively generating \$40 billion USD each year. In the last five years, the number of international schools in Asia has grown by 10%. This growth shows no sign of slowing, with close to 200 new schools planned to open in Asia by 2027.



### **2024 Conference Highlights**

#### **Imagining Alternative Educational Futures in the Present**



Last year, Dr Elke van Dermijnsbrugge delivered a captivating talk highlighting how global crises can act as catalysts for reimagining education. She encouraged educators to creatively envision schools that embody alternative futures while emphasising the importance of possibility and mutual aid. She delved into educational practices incorporating imaginative, utopian, and speculative thinking and actions. She redefined the pivotal role of education and schools, suggesting that alternative futures can take shape now.
