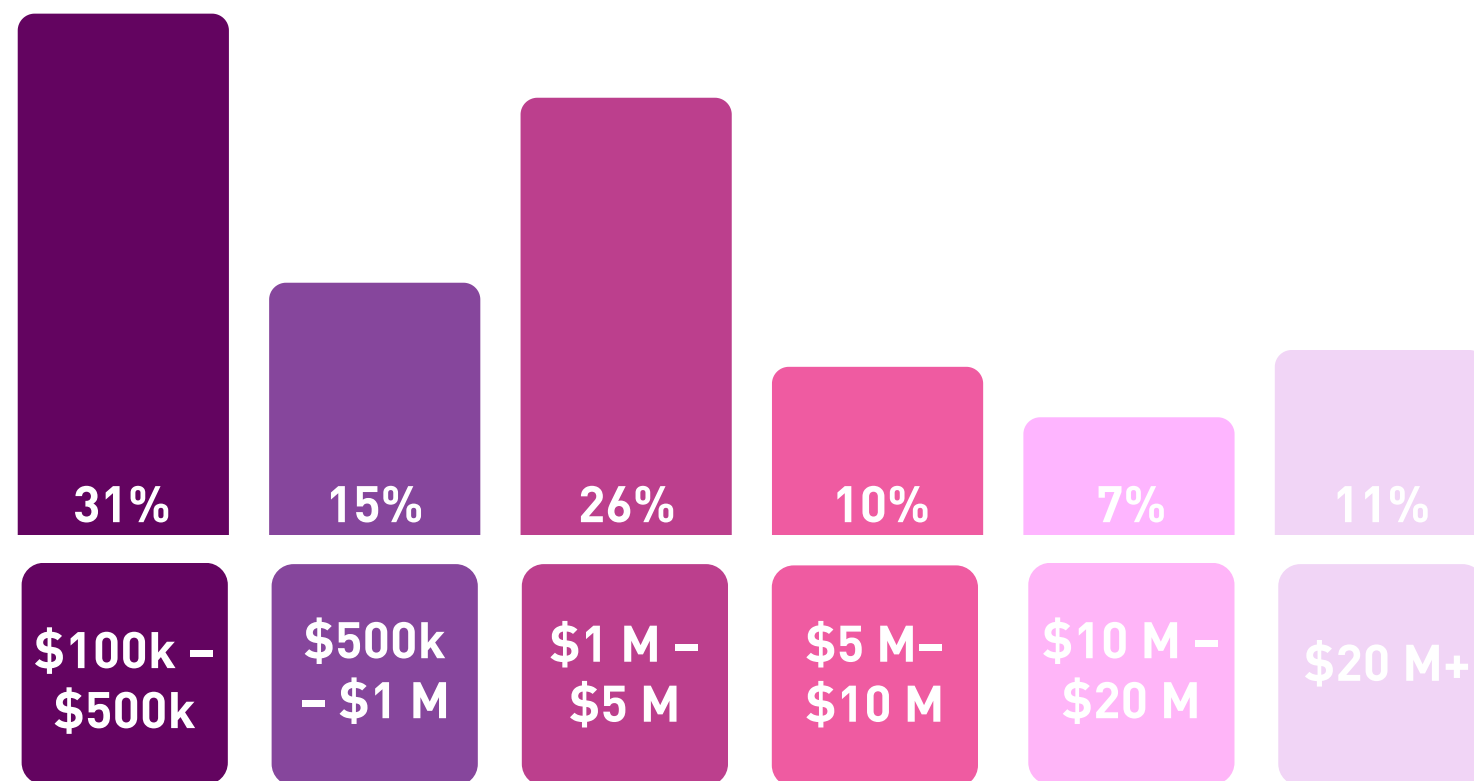
ABOUT EDUTECH

Thank you to everyone who joined us. We're excited to share the full event stats and highlights in this report, and we look forward to seeing you again in 2026!

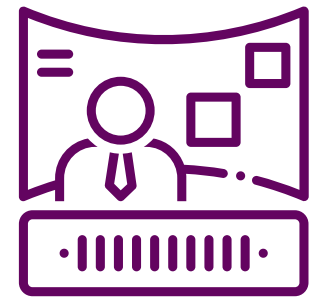

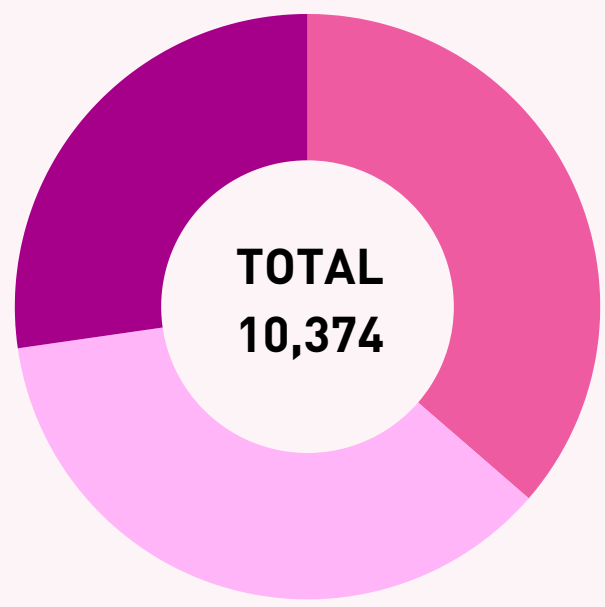

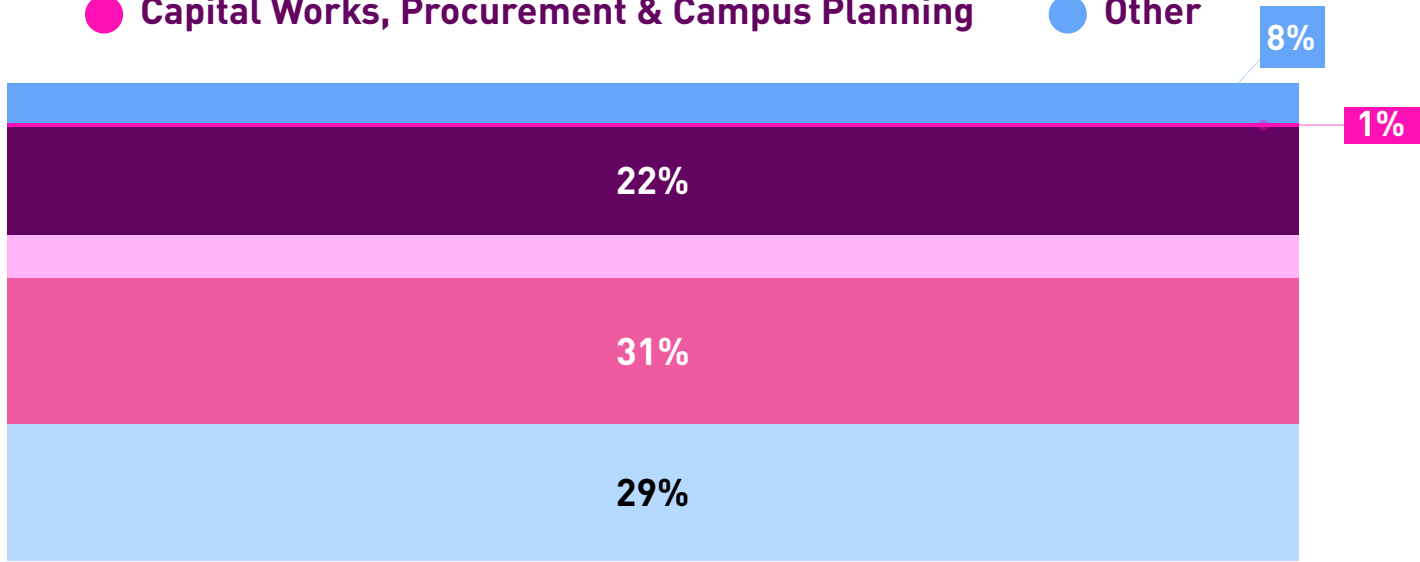
DECISION MAKERS VS INFLUENCERS

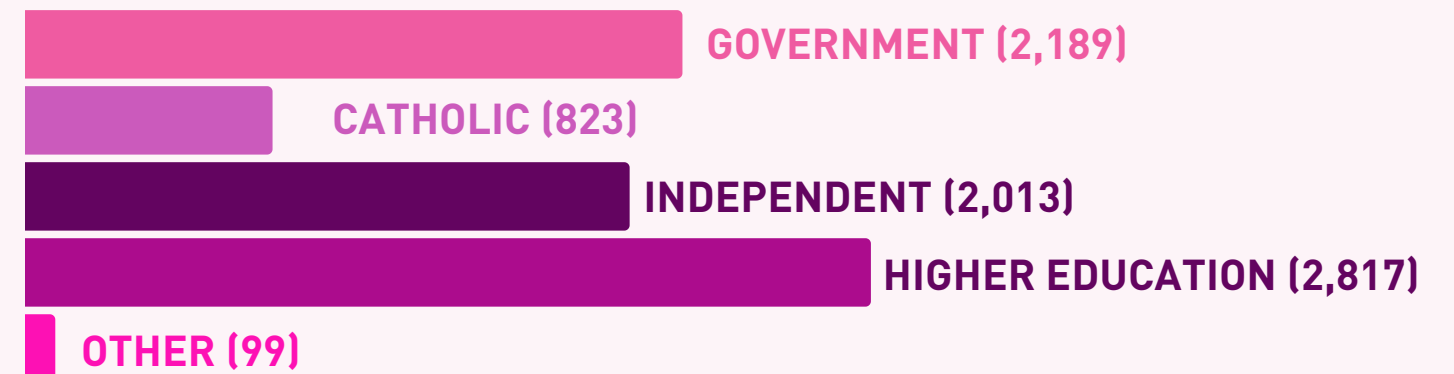

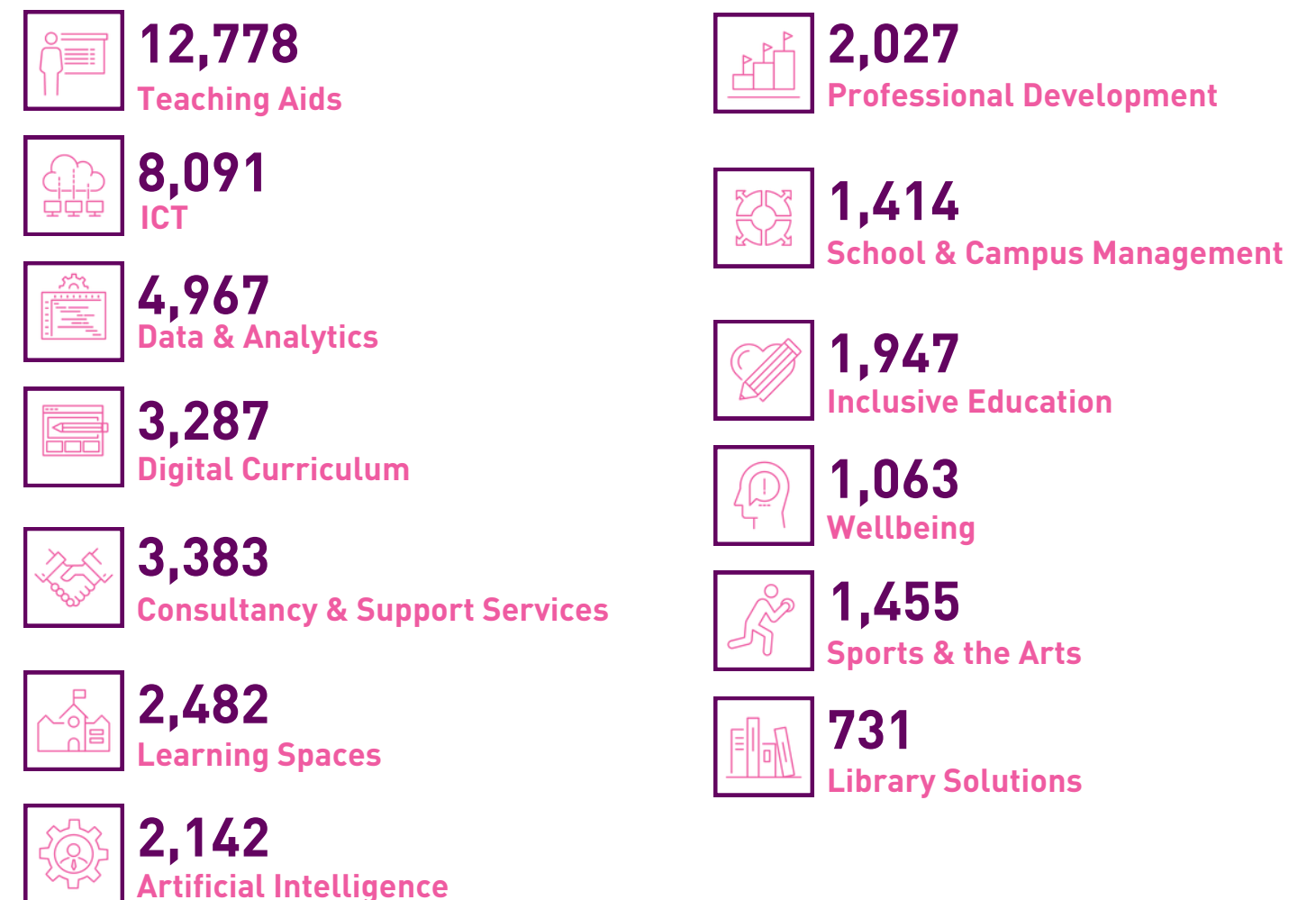
